

CHAPTER LXVII.

An Act to amend Section twenty (20) of Chapter eighty-one (81) of the General Statutes, relating to the record of proof of publication of notices of mortgage sales. March 3, 1869.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section twenty (20) of Chapter eighty one (81) of the General Statutes. Affidavit to be recorded at length by the Register of Deeds.

2. Legalization of affidavits recorded previous to passage of this act.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section twenty (20) of chapter eighty-one (81) of the general statutes, on page five hundred and sixty-five, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 20. Such affidavit shall be recorded at length by the register of deeds of the county in which the premises are situated, in a book kept for the record of deeds; and such original affidavits, the record thereof, and certified copies of such record, shall be presumptive evidence of the facts therein contained. Affidavit to be recorded.

SEC. 2. All such affidavits heretofore recorded in books of deeds instead of mortgages in the several counties of this state, and the records thereof are hereby legalized to all intents and for all purposes to the same extent as though the same had been recorded in books of mortgages. Previous affidavits legalized.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and in sixty days after its passage. When act to take effect.
