CHAPTER VII.

An Act to appropriate moneys for the erection of a State March 5, 1869. Reform School building.

- SECTION 1. Appropriation for the purpose of the erection and completion of the State Reform School.
 - 2. It shall be unlawful to expend more than the amount of appropriation in the erection and completion of any building.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the sum of twenty thousand dollars, or as much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury Appropriation for State Reform not otherwise appropriated, for the purpose of the erection, School. completion and equipment of the state reform school: Provided, That no more than ten thousand dollars of said sum shall be paid out of the treasury until after the first day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy.

It shall be unlawful for the trustees of the No more than state reform school, and the same shall have no authority appropriation to be expended. to crect or contract for the erection of any building which, when completed and equipped ready for use, shall have cost the state a greater sum than the amount hereby appropriated therefor.
