SECTION 1. That there is hereby created a state board of immigration for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, consisting of the governor of state, who Board of Immishall be ex-officio chairman, the secretary of state, Rev. gration-duties. Aaker, who are to serve without pay, and whose duty it shall be to use all necessary and reasonable means for the promotion of immigration to the state of Minnesota.
