

CHAPTER XCIV.

An Act to define the boundary lines of Lyon County, and attach the same to Redwood County for judicial purposes. March 2, 1869.

- SECTION 1. Boundary lines of the County of Lyon.
2. To be submitted to the legal voters of Redwood County—ballots how prepared—returns how made.
 3. Attached to Redwood County for judicial purposes.
 4. When act to take effect.
 5. Repeal of inconsistent acts.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The boundary line of Lyon county is hereby established and hereafter shall be as follows: Beginning at the south-east corner of township one hundred and nine (109), range forty (40), thence due north to the north-east corner of township one hundred and thirteen (113), range forty west of the fifth principal meridian, thence west to the boundary line of the state of Minnesota, thence south on the boundary line of the state to the township line between townships one hundred and eight (108) and one hundred and nine (109), thence east on said township line to the place of beginning.

SEC. 2. At the time of giving notice of the next general election, it shall be the duty of the officers of the county of Redwood, as required by law to give notice of such election, to give notice in like manner, that at said election a vote will be taken on the question of changing the boundary lines of Redwood county in accordance with the provisions of this act. At said election the voters of said county of Redwood in favor of the change proposed by this act shall have distinctly written or printed or partly written or printed on their ballots, "For change of boundary lines of Redwood county in favor of Lyon county," and returns thereof shall be made to the same office by the judges of election of the several townships

and by the auditor of said Redwood county as upon votes for state officers.

Attached to Redwood County for judicial purposes.

SEC. 3. The county of Lyon is hereby attached for judicial purposes to the county of Redwood.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 4. The foregoing provisions of this act shall take effect and be in force from and after the ratification and adoption of the proposed change by a majority of the voters of Redwood county.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 5. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

CHAPTER XCV.

March 5, 1869. *An Act for the support and encouragement of the Minnesota Historical Society.*

- SECTION 1. Appropriation for the support of the Historical Society—to be expended by the Executive Council—to make report to Governor—what to contain.
2. Library to be kept open to the public.
 3. To cause to be properly bound the collection of unbound newspapers—deficiency in files how filled.
 4. State Librarian to keep record of volumes transferred from State Library to said Society.
 5. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

For support of Historical Society—who to expend appropriation—to make report.

SECTION 1. That for the better support and more enlarged usefulness of the Minnesota Historical Society, there is hereby appropriated, out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, the sum of two thousand dollars, which shall be paid to, and expended by the executive council of said society, in such manner as they may deem will best promote its objects and aid its purposes; and said executive council shall, at the close of
