CHAPTER CIII.

March 8, 1869. An Act to incorporate the Lenora School District in the County of Fillmore, and State of Minnesota.

SECTION 1. Boundary lines of said School District.

- What to constitute a Board of Education—term of office—when first annual election to be held.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the territory of the following description, to-wit: Section three, section two, and west half section one, section ten and eleven; west half section twelve; west half east half of section twelve; west threefourths of the north half of the north half of section thirteen; the east half of north half of the north half of section fourteen; and north half section fifteen, town one hundred and one, range nine, in the county of Fillmore, shall constitute one school district under the general school laws of this state, except so far as modified by this act, by the name of the Lenora School District, and by such name may contract and be contracted with, sue and be sued in any court of this state having competent jurisdiction, and in its corporate name shall hold the title of all lands and other property now held or that may hereafter be acquired for school district purposes in said district.

SEC. 2. The officers of said district shall constitute a board of education, and shall consist of three members who shall be elected by the legal voters of said district,

Provided further, That the first unnual election shall be held on the first Saturday in April next.

SEC. 3. Within ten days after each annual election, when board to said board of education shall meet and after being duly most election qualified shall elect one of the number president, and tressurer. clerk and treasurer. The clerks and treasurer shall perform the duties under the same restrictions which are now or

may be provided in the general school laws.

Sec. 4. The board of education shall have power to Power of board, sell and convey the school house and lands and other district property now belonging to said district, provided the proceeds are applied towards erecting and furnishing another school house, and the said board shall have a. general supervision of the school, hire teachers and decide in what terms scholars from out side of said district may attend.

Sec. 5. The board of education of said district are To Lesue bonds hereby authorized to issue the bonds of said district for pose. the purpose of building and furnishing a school house in said district, in a sum not exceeding twenty-five hundred dollars, in such denominations as the board shall determine.

SEC. 6. Such bonds shall bear a rate of interest not Rate of interest exceeding twelve per cent. per annum, payable annually, and the principal shall be payable as follows: One-third in one year; one-third in two years; one-third in three years from the date of said lands.

SEC. 7. The bonds issued under the provision of the By whom bonds act shall be signed by the president, and countersigned by to be signed—the clerks, and the said clerks shall keep a correct record the same. of all bonds so issued, giving the number, date and amount, to whom issued and when payable.

SEC. 8. The said board of education shall have power who to negotito regulate said bonds as they shall deem best for the ate said bonds. interests of the district, they shall appropriate said bonds

for the purposes herein specified and no other.

Sec. 9. The said board for the purpose of paying the principal and interest on said bonds, are hereby authorized at any regular or special meeting to pay taxes amounting Annual tax levto the principal and interest about to become due, with purpose. ten per cent. added for delinquent taxes, taxes upon the . real and personal property in said district prior to the

interest becoming due on the maturity of said bonds, and such levy shall forthwith be transmitted by the clerks of said board to the county auditor, whose duty it shall be year by year to piace upon the tax rolls the proportion of such levy assigned thereto, which taxes therefore be collected with other taxes.

To be submitted to legal voters.

SEC. 10. This act shall be submitted to the legal voters of said Lenora School District for their adoption or rejection at a meeting called for that purpose, in the same manner as provided by law for the calling of special meetings, and no bonds shall be issued until it shall have been adopted by a majority of the votes at said meeting.

CHAPTER CIV.

March 5, 1869.

An Act to locate, survey and establish a State Road from: Jackson, in Jackson County, to Madelia, in Watonwan County.

SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed to locate, survey and establish said road.

- Where and when Commissioners to meet—vacancy, how filled.
- Commissioners may employ surveyor, &c.—compensation.
- 4. How expenses of locating said road to be defrayed.
- 5. Damages sustained, how ascertained.
- Commissioners to file plat of road.
- When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Commissioners appointed. SECTION 1. That Hiram S. Bailey, B. W. Ashley and W. C. Rhoads are hereby appointed commissioners to locate, survey and establish a state road from Jackson, in Jackson county, to Madelia, in Watonwan county.
