SEC. 2. The commissioners, or a majority of them, -shall meet in the town of Fish Lake, in Chisago county, when and on or before the first day of July, A. D. one thousand where to meet. eight hundred and sixty nine, and then proceed to locate and survey said road, or such portions of said road, as in their judgment a majority of them may agree upon or deem advisable for the best interests of the counties through which said road may pass.

SEC. 3. The said commissioners are hereby empowered May employ a to employ one surveyor, one axeman and two chainmen. surveyor, &c.

SEC. 4. The expenses of surveying, locating and es-Expenses, how tablishing said road, and the damages, if any, shall be to be defrayed. paid by the several counties through which said road shall run, each county paying the expense incurred within its own limits.

This act shall take effect and be in torce from when act to Sec. 5. and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXV.

An Act to provide for the location of a State Road from Glencoe, in McLeod County, to the line of the St. Paul March 6, 1869. and Pacific Railroad, in Wright County.

SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed to locate, survey and establish said road.

- 2. When and where to meet-vacancy, how filled.
- 3. May appoint a surveyor, &c.-to file plat of road.
- 4. How expenses of locating said road to be defrayed.
- 5. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That R. B. Young, of the town of Rich Commissioners Valley, and county of McLeod, and Slocum Wooly, of what purpose. the town of Hale, and county of McLeod, and Charles

Goodsel, of the town of Victor, and county of Wright, are hereby appointed commissioners to lay out, locate and survey a state road from the line of the St. Paul and Pacific Railroad by them to be selected in Wright county to Glencoe, in McLeod county.

When and where to meetvacancy, how filled. SEC. 2. Said commissioners shall meet at the residence of Chas. Goodsel, town and county aforesaid, on a day to be by them fixed between the first days of May and July next, and proceed to discharge the duties imposed on them by the provisions of this act; *Provided*, That in the absence of any one of said commissioners the other two shall have power to fill said vacancy, by the appointment of some suitable person who shall have the same powers and perform the same duties as the said commissioners above named.

May appoint a surveyor, &c.—to file plat of road.

SEC. 3. Said commissioners are hereby empowered to employ one surveyor, flagman, axman and two chainmen, and shall locate, survey, mark and plat the aforementioned road, provided the commissioners may at their discretion adopt the location, survey and plat of any state, county or town road or any part of any such survey and plat of any such road lying along the route of said proposed road, which said plat or plats shall be filed in the office of the register of deeds in each county through which said road may pass, which said plat shall be legal evidence of the location and establishment of said road.

Expenses, how to be defrayed.

SEC. 4. The expense of locating and surveying said road shall be paid by the several counties through which the same may pass.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
