Irvine, is hereby authorized and empowered to bargain, sell, grant and convey, at public or private sale, any or all of the real estate of said minors, or either of them, lying and being in the state of Minnesota.

Guardians may sell property of said minors.

SEC. 2. No deed of any such property shall be of any force until the said judge of probate shall have endorsed his approval thereon.

How deeds be endorsed

SEC. 3. Said guardian shall account to said judge for all moneys received by him for such sale.

To account for all moneys received.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER CXXV.

An Act for the adoption of Carrie Isabel King by William S. King and Carrie May King. March 4, 1869.

SECTION 1. Change of name—declared lawful heir of William S. and Carrie May King.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That Carrie Isabel King, be, and she is hereby declared to be the legally adopted daughter of William S. and Carrie May King, of the city of Minneapolis, and state of Minnesota, and that she shall enjoy all the privileges and inheritances and be subject to all the obligations and duties the same as if she had been the legitimate daughter of the said William S. and Carrie May King, born in lawful wedlock.

Change of name.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CXXVI.

Feb'y 23, 1869.

An Act to amend and continue the act entitled An Act to incorporate the Stillwater Ferry Company.

- SECTION 1. The provisions of the act approved March 2d, 1855, granting said charter are hereby continued in full force.
2. The rights and powers are hereby transferred and vested in James S. Anderson—for what length of time continued.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Former act continued in force.

SECTION 1. That all and singular the provisions of the act of the legislative assembly of the territory of Minnesota, entitled "An act to incorporate the Stillwater ferry company," approved March second (2d), one thousand eight hundred and fifty five, be and the same are continued in full force, and the same are confirmed to said corporation, its successor and assigns in all respects, except only in so far as the same is modified, amended or changed by the provisions of this act.

Rights and powers transferred to J. S. Anderson—length of time continued.

SEC. 2. That the rights and powers conferred upon Isaac Staples, John McKusick, Christopher Carli, Elias McKean, Jonathan E. McKusick and Albert Harris, and their associates and assigns, be and the same are continued to and vested in James S. Anderson, the successor in interest of said corporators and their associates, successors and assigns. That said James S. Anderson, his successors or assigns, so invested with rights, franchises and privileges, shall continue, with the same powers and privileges conferred that are contained in the act to which this is an amendment, and be subject to the same penalties,
