

CHAPTER XLI.

An Act to amend an act entitled "An Act to authorize the Village of Lake City to aid in the construction of the Saint Paul and Chicago Railway," approved March sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight.

Feb'y 2, 1869.

SECTION 1. Amendment to the act approved March 6, 1868. The word "town," substituted for the word "village"—extension of time for redemption of bonds.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the act entitled "an act to authorize the village of Lake City to aid in the construction of the Saint Paul and Chicago Railway," approved March sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, be and the same is hereby amended as follows, to wit: The word "town," shall be and is hereby substituted for and in the place of the word "village," wherever it occurs in said act; and the word "thirty," likewise substituted for the word "twenty," preceding the word "years," in the first section of said act, and the word "ten," likewise substituted for the word "thirty," preceding the word "days," in the second section of said act.

Substitute the word 'town,' for 'village,'—time for redeeming bonds extended.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
