

deemed criminal proceedings, and shall be prosecuted and determined as provided by the law for the prosecution of offences cognizable before justices of the peace; and in all cases of conviction under this act, one-half of all fines and penalties collected shall be paid over by the justice or person collecting the same to the person who shall make complaint in the case, and the complainant shall not be required to give security for costs.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER LXXIX.

An Act to amend the General Law relating to the fees of County Treasurers, so as to reduce the fees of the County Treasurer of Ramsey County, for the collection of the taxes of the City of Saint Paul. March 4, 1869.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section one hundred and fifty (150) of Chapter eight (8) of the General Laws. Fees of Treasurer of Ramsey County.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one hundred and fifty (150) of chapter eight (8) of the general laws of the state, be amended by adding the following proviso at the end of said section, viz: *Provided*, That the county treasurer of Ramsey shall be allowed but one (1) per cent. upon all taxes or assessments levied or assessed by the city of Saint Paul, and collected and paid over by him to the city treasurer of said city. Fees of treasurer of Ramsey county.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after the first of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy. When act to take effect.
