

CHAPTER LXXXV.

An Act to amend chapter one hundred and nine (109) of the Special Laws of eighteen hundred and sixty-eight (1868), being an Act to authorize the Register of Deeds of Goodhue County to transcribe and record town plats.

March 1, 1869.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section one (1) of Chapter one hundred and nine (109) of the Special Laws of 1868. County Commissioners shall allow a reasonable compensation for transcribing town plats.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one (1) of chapter one hundred and nine (109) of the special laws of eighteen hundred and sixty eight (1868) be, and the same is hereby amended by adding to said section one the following: And the county commissioners shall allow a reasonable compensation for transcribing the said town plats as provided for in this section, not exceeding the rate now allowed by law for recording town plats.

Commissioners to fix pay for transcribing town plats.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
