

## CHAPTER CVI.

*An Act to appropriate money for the support and maintenance of the Minnesota State Reform School.*

Feb'y 10, 1870.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for the support and maintenance of the State Reform School.

1. For stoves, boilers and fixtures in laundry, &c.
  2. For furnishing the new building.
  3. For current expenses for the year 1870.
2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the support and maintenance of the Minnesota State Reform School, as hereinafter specified, viz :

Appropriation for support of the Reform School.

*First*—For stoves, boilers and fixtures in laundry, kitchen, bake room, &c., the sum of five hundred dollars.

*Second*—For furnishing the new building, the sum of six hundred dollars.

*Third*—For the current expenses of the year A. D. 1870, the sum of nine thousand dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
