Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, not otherwise appropriated, viz :

First—For the claim of M. H. Bergholtz against the United States, forty-eight dollars and seventy-five cents (\$48.75.)

CHAPTER CIX.

March 4, 1870.

An Act to appropriate money for certain purposes.

- SECTION 1. Appropriation to pay balance due for work performed in putting in heating apparatus in First Normal School Building—in what amount.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Appropriation for balance due for putting heating apparatus in First Normal School building.

SECTION 1. That the sum of two thousand two hundred and six dollars and sixty-eight cents be and the same is hereby appropriated to J. W. Wentworth, out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, for balance due him for work performed putting in heating and ventilating apparatus in the First State Normal School at Winona.
