## CHAPTER CXVI.

An Act to appropriate money to pay the claims of Mathias March 4, 1870. Theirs and Mathias Mergens.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for certain purposes therein named :

- 1. For Mathias Theirs for value of horse taken in Indian campaign.
- 2. For Mathias Mergens for damage to horse taken in Indian campaign.
- 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, not otherwise appropriated, viz:

First-To Mathias Theirs (Hartman), for value of horse taken by order of Brig. Gen. Sibley, and which died in the service, one hundred and twenty-five dollars (\$125).

Second-To Mathias Mergens, for damages to horse taken by order of Gen. Sibley, in Indian campaign, ninety dollars (\$90). Provided, The said claims shall not be paid until allowed by the government of the United States.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from When act to take effect. and after its passage.
