CHAPTER XV.

An Act to encourage the establishing of Watering Places Feb's 16, 157. on the highways.

SECTION 1. Any person who shall construct and maintain a watering trough beside the highway and made accessible for horses, shall be allowed a deduction in his highway tex-in what amount.

- 2. X reduction in highway tax for maintaining and keeping in repair a good well or spring beside the highway-in what amount.
- 3. When there are two or more claimants, who to decide.
- When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Any person in any city, town or township Any person main-in this state, who shall construct and maintain and keep trough slong the in repair a watering trough beside the highway, which highway to be allowed reduction shall be above the ground and made easily accessible for of tax-amount. horses and carriages, shall be allowed by the city, town or township, five dollars out of his highway tax for each year during which he shall furnish the same.

SEC. 2. Any person in any city, town or township Others allowed who shall construct and maintain and keep in repair a good reduction-for well or spring beside the highway, and easily accessible, amount. and provide it with a suitable pail or bucket, and keep the same se supplied and in good repair, shall be allowed by the city, town or township, three dollars out of his highway tax for each year during which he shall furnish the same.

SEC. 3. If more than one person upon the same line of if more than one road or any highway, district or ward, shall claim to fur decide. nish such watering trough, well or spring, the alderman of the city or supervisors of the town shall decide where such trough, well or spring shall be located.

This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to take Sec. 4. effect. and after its passage.
