

CHAPTER XXVIII.

An Act to amend Section Fifty-Four, of Title Three, of Chapter Thirty-Four, of the General Statutes, relating to Corporations.

March 3, 1870.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section Fifty-Four (54) of Chapter Thirty-Four (34) of the General Statutes. Incorporation of Societies for the purpose of Improvement in the Arts and Sciences, Literary or Social Culture.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That section fifty-four, of chapter thirty-four, of the general statutes, be amended so as to read as follows :

Sec. 54. Any number of persons not less than three may associate themselves and become incorporated for the purpose of establishing and conducting colleges, seminaries, lyceums, or any scientific, medical, legal, agricultural, benevolent or missionary society, fire department association, or any society for the purpose of instruction or mutual improvement in any art or science, or for literary or social culture, as provided herein.

Societies may be incorporated—
for what purpose.

SEC. 2. That this act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
