CHAPTER LXVIII.

An Act to amend Section Four, of Chapter Eighty-Two, of the General Statutes, Relating to Judgment by Confession.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section Four (4) of Chapter Eighty-Two (82) of the General Statutes. Strike out the word "copy," and insert "authority."

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The word "copy" in the first line of the second sub-division of section four, of chapter eighty-two, of the general statutes, is hereby stricken out and the word "authority" is hereby inserted in place therein.
