## CHAPTER LXXVII.

*An Act to amend Section Nine, of Chapter Seventy, of the General Statutes, relating to fees of witnesses in criminal cases.*

March 3, 1870.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section Nine (9) of Chapter Seventy (70) of the General Statutes.

Fees of witnesses in criminal cases.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That section nine, of chapter seventy, of the general statutes, be amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 9. Witnesses for the state in criminal cases before any court of record shall receive for such attendance, one dollar for each day, and six cents per mile in going to and returning from the place of attendance. And the judges of the district court may, in their discretion, allow fees to witnesses attending in criminal proceedings on behalf of the defendant, which shall not exceed the fees allowed by law in civil actions. Such allowances shall be certified by the clerk of the court and paid in the same manner that jurors are paid.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

### CHAPTER LXXVIII.

*An Act to amend, re-enact and restore Sections One Hundred and Thirty-Nine and One Hundred and Forty, of Chapter Sixty-Five, of General Statutes, and to repeal Section One, of Chapter Eighty-One, of the Session Laws of the year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-Seven, relating to jurisdiction of justices (in) criminal cases and the proceedings therein.*

March 7, 1870.

- SECTION 1. Restoration of former Sections.  
 2. Repeal of former Section.  
 3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

Restoration of former section.

SECTION 1. That sections one hundred and thirty-nine and one hundred and forty, of chapter sixty-five of the general statutes, be and the same are hereby re-enacted and restored to full force and effect with the following amendment: That the word six be stricken out of the sixth line of section one hundred and forty, and inserting in place thereof the word twelve.

Repeal of former section.

SEC. 2. That section one, of chapter eighty-one, of the session laws of the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, be and the same is hereby repealed.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
