

CHAPTER VIII.

*An Act entitled An Act to Appropriate money for the
Purchase of Additional Land for the Minnesota State
Reform School.*

March 4, 1871.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for the purchase of additional land for the use of said Reform School—by whom drawn and expended.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

Appropriation to purchase land for reform school—by whom drawn and expended.

SECTION 1. That the sum of seven thousand dollars or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, for the purchase of additional land for the use of said State Reform School, the same to be drawn and expended by the said board of managers.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
