Feb'y 24, 1870. An Act to amend Section Twelve, of Chapter Ten, of the General Statutes of Minnesota.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section Twelve (12) of Chapter Ten (10) of the General Statutes.

 When annual town meetings to be held.
 - 2. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
 - 3. When act to take effect,

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That section twelve, of chapter ten, of the revised statutes of Minnesota, be amended so as to read as follows:

When annual town meeting to be held.

Sec. 12. The citizens of the several towns of this state qualified to vote at general elections, shall annually assemble and hold town meetings in their respective towns on the second Tuesday of March, at such place in each town as the electors thereof, at their annual town meetings from time to time appoint, and notice of the time and place of holding such meeting shall be given by the town clerk by posting up written or printed notices in three of the most public places in said town at least ten days prior to said meeting.

Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 2. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent with this act are hereby repealed.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect from and after the first day of May next.
