

CHAPTER CL.

An Act to authorize the Clerk of the District Court of Dakota County, First Judicial District, to perfect certain records in his office. March 7, 1870.

SECTION 1. Duty of Clerk of District Court.

2. To have same validity as the originals.
3. Fees of Clerk of District Court.
4. Authorized to record and index the returns of all executions—*fees*.
5. Authorized to procure suitable index books—for what purpose.
6. From what fund fees paid.
7. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. The clerk of the district court in and for the county of Dakota, first judicial district, is hereby authorized and required to procure such books and index books, at the expense of the county of Dakota, as may be necessary, and record therein all declarations of intentions to become citizens of the United States, and all final papers of citizens now on file in his office, but not of record, and index the same in alphabetical order. Duty of clerk of district court.

SEC. 2. The said declarations of intentions, and the said final papers so recorded, shall be of the same validity and entitled to the same force and effect as the originals themselves. To have same validity as the originals.

SEC. 3. The clerk of the district court of said county shall be allowed twenty-five cents for recording each declaration of intention; and he shall be allowed twenty-five cents for recording the several affidavits of each applicant and his witnesses, and a like amount for recording the order of the court admitting the applicant to be a citizen. Fees of clerk.

SEC. 4. The clerk of the district court in and for the county of Dakota, first judicial district, is hereby authorized and required to record and index the return of all executions issued by said court from January, one thou- To record and index the returns of all executions—*fees*.

sand eight hundred and fifty-four, to January, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, for which he shall be allowed the sum of twenty-five cents each.

To procure index

SEC. 5. The clerk of the district court of the county of Dakota, first judicial district, is hereby authorized and required to procure suitable index books, and index in alphabetical order court records number one, and of record number one of marriage certificate and credentials of ordinations of ministers of the gospel; for which he shall be allowed ten cents for indexing each case or order entered on said court record, and ten cents for indexing each marriage certificate and ordination certificate.

From what fund

SEC. 6. All services authorized to be paid by this act shall be paid out of the treasury of the county of Dakota.

When act to take
effect.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER CII.

Feb'y 28, 1870.

An Act to authorize the Clerk of the District Court, Sixth Judicial District, in and for the county of Brown to transcribe the records of his office.

SECTION 1. Clerk of District Court authorized to procure books to transcribe records of his office.

2. Not to affect the validity of the documents transferred.
3. Fees of Clerk.
4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. The clerk of the district court in and for the county of Brown, is hereby authorized and required to procure as far as may be necessary such book or books as may be required to carry out the provisions of this act,
