by exempt from taxation to the amount limited by their charter.

CHAPTER CXXVI.

An Act to amend an act relating to change of names of certain towns in Douglas County.

March 3, 1870,

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Chapter Eighty-Two (82) of the Special Laws of 1869.
 - 2. The town of Roelyn changed to that of Hudson.
 - 3. Change of name of Maple Lake to that of Hudson Lake.
 - 4. The town of Atkinsville changed to that of Mos.
 - 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That chapter eighty-two, of special laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, approved Amendment to former chapter. March fifth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty nine, be and the same is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

- That the town of Roslyn, in Douglas county, Town of Roslyn shall hereafter be designated and known as the town of changed to that Hudson.
- Sec. 3. That the body of water known as Maple Lake, Name of Maple in Douglas county, shall hereafter be designated and Lake changed to known as Lake Hudson.

Hudson Lake.

Sec. 4. That the town of Atkinsville, in Douglas Town of Atkinscounty, shall hereafter be designated and known as the ville changed to town of Moe.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from when act to take and after its passage.
