

CHAPTER CXXXIII.

*An Act to legalize the sale and conveyance of real estate of
Frank P. Hamilton, a minor.*Feb'y 28, 1870.

SECTION 1. Description of property conveyed by guardian—conveyance confirmed and legalized.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Property convey-
ed by guardian—
sale legalized.

SECTION 1. That the sale of the south-east quarter of the south-east quarter of section number twenty-nine, and the east half of the north-east quarter and the south-west quarter of the north-east quarter of section thirty-two, in township one hundred and fourteen, range twenty, in Dakota county, made by N. Virginia Longstreet as the guardian of Frank P. Hamilton, a minor, to Lemuel Fountain, August sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, for the sum of two thousand and thirty-two dollars, which sale was confirmed by the probate court of said county, August nineteenth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, and the deeds of said real estate executed by said N. Virginia Longstreet as such guardian to said Fountain, be and the same are hereby legalized and made valid.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
