

## CHAPTER CXL.

*An Act to authorize Albert Galloway, Guardian, to sell  
and convey real estate.*

Feb'y 28, 1870.

SECTION 1. Guardian authorized to dispose of property of said wards at public or private sale.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. That Albert Galloway, of the village of Austin, in this state, guardian of the persons and estate of William Galloway and Ellen Galloway, minor heirs of Rosette Galloway, now deceased, is hereby authorized and empowered, with the approval of the judge of probate of the county of Mower, to bargain, sell, grant and convey at public or private sale, any or all of the real estate of which the said Rosette Galloway died seized, for such sum or sums of money and on such terms as in his judgment may seem for the best interest of said wards.

To dispose of property of wards at public or private sale.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
