

SEC. 3. The said commissioners shall file a certified plat of the survey of said road in the office of the county auditors of each of said counties, which plat shall be legal evidence of the location and existence of said road.

Commissioners to file plat of road.

SEC. 4. All damages sustained by the laying out and opening said road, shall be ascertained and determined by said commissioners or a majority of them, and shall be paid by the county in which such damages occur.

Damages, how ascertained.

SEC. 5. Each county through which said road shall pass, shall pay the reasonable expense incurred in laying out and surveying the same in such county.

How expenses of locating road to be defrayed.

SEC. 6. The board of county commissioners of Hennepin county, are hereby authorized and empowered to appropriate money belonging to said county to such an amount as they may deem advisable, not however exceeding the sum of three thousand dollars, to aid in the building and bridging of that part of said proposed road lying within the limits of Hennepin county.

To appropriate money—for what purpose—what amount.

SEC. 7. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.

## CHAPTER CXLIV.

*An Act to establish a State Road from Glencoe via Cokato to some point in Wright County.*

March 7, 1870.

- SECTION 1. Commissioners appointed to locate, survey and establish said road.
2. When and where to meet—may employ a surveyor and other assistance—expenses, how paid.
  3. Surveyor to file plat of road.
  4. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That W. R. Hawkins and Demrey Mar-

Commissioners appointed to locate a state road.

shall, of McLeod county, and E. B. McCord, of Wright county, are hereby appointed commissioners to locate, survey and establish a state road from the village of Glencoe via Cokato in Wright county to such point in said county as said commissioners may deem expedient.

When and where to meet—may employ surveyor, &c.—expenses, how paid.

SEC. 2. The commissioners or a majority of them shall meet at Glencoe, in McLeod county, on or before the first Monday in April, one thousand eight hundred and seventy, or as soon thereafter as practicable, and proceed to locate and survey said road as provided for in this act, and said commissioners are hereby empowered to employ one axman, one surveyor and two chainmen, and all reasonable expenses incurred in locating and surveying said road shall be paid by the counties through which said road shall pass respectively.

Surveyor to file plat of road.

SEC. 3. Said commissioners shall cause a good substantial stake, properly marked, set at each end and at each angle, and a profile of said road shall be made by the surveyor and filed in the office of the register of deeds in each county through which said road may pass, with accurate field notes of said survey attached to said plat or profile, which shall be prima facts evidence of the legal existence of so much of said road as the profile represents.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
