

CHAPTER CL.

An Act to legalize the survey, location and establishment of the State Road running from a point at or near St. Joseph, in Stearns County, via Birch Bark, Fort Lake, to Round Prairie, in Todd County. March 2, 1870.

- SECTION 1. Provisions of former act legalized and confirmed—Commissioners appointed—
for what purpose.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the state road surveyed, located and established in pursuance of an act entitled "An act to provide for the survey, location and establishment of a state road from a point at or near St. Joseph, in Stearns county, via Birch Bark, Fort Lake, to Round Prairie, in Todd county," approved March sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-seven, be and the same is hereby legalized and declared to be a valid existing and established state road, and the filing of the plat of the survey thereof declared to be regular, and Peter Loso, Nicholas Keppers, Senior, and Isaac Obermiller, are hereby named as commissioners, and empowered to assess damages and to do and perform all and singular the acts and things necessary to be done and performed to carry the said act and the provisions thereof into effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
