

## CHAPTER CLI.

March 3, 1870. *An Act to legalize the action of the Board of Supervisors of the Town of Bloomington, in Hennepin County, in laying out and opening a Road in said Town.*

SECTION 1. The action of the Board of Supervisors affirmed and legalized.

2. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That the action of the board of supervisors of the town of Bloomington, in Hennepin county, in laying out and opening the road heretofore surveyed by Donald McCallum, and commencing on the Shakopee Road at the southeast corner of the northeast quarter of section numbered nine, in township numbered twenty-seven, of range twenty-four west of the fourth principal meridian, thence west two miles through the centre of sections nine and eight, and ending at the southwest corner of the northwest quarter of section eight, in said township and range, is hereby affirmed and legalized, and declared to be in all respects valid.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force and take effect from and after its passage.
