CHAPTER XXXIII.

An Act to authorize the City of Winona to appropriate money to defray the expenses of surveying routes for why 29, 1870. Railroads terminating at Winona.

- SECTION 1. City Council authorized to appropriate certain moneys—not to exceed what amount-for what purpose.
 - 2. Authorised to levy a tax for the purpose of paying the amount of said appropriation.
 - 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. The city council of the city of Winona are Council authorhereby authorized to appropriate a sum or sums not exset to appropriate ceeding in the aggregate three thousand dollars, to defray —amount-for
what purpose. the expense of surveying routes for railroads to or from the city of Winona.

SEC. 2. For the purpose of raising the money to pay Tolery a tax-any appropriation made under the preceding section, the for, what purpose. city council of the city of Winona shall have power to levy and collect in the same manner as other city taxes are levied and collected, sufficient tax to pay the amount so appropriated.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from When act to take

and after its passage.
