

CHAPTER XXXIII.

An Act to authorize the City of Winona to appropriate money to defray the expenses of surveying routes for Railroads terminating at Winona.

Feb'y 28, 1870.

- SECTION 1. City Council authorized to appropriate certain moneys—not to exceed what amount—for what purpose.
2. Authorised to levy a tax for the purpose of paying the amount of said appropriation,
 3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. The city council of the city of Winona are hereby authorized to appropriate a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate three thousand dollars, to defray the expense of surveying routes for railroads to or from the city of Winona.

Council authorized to appropriate certain money—amount—for what purpose.

SEC. 2. For the purpose of raising the money to pay any appropriation made under the preceding section, the city council of the city of Winona shall have power to levy and collect in the same manner as other city taxes are levied and collected, sufficient tax to pay the amount so appropriated.

To levy a tax—for what purpose.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
