

SEC. 2. That so much of said road as has been changed and located as aforesaid, be and the same is hereby declared to be in all respects a legal highway, and that the survey and plat thereof on file in the office of the town clerk of said township of West St. Paul, be and the same is hereby declared to be legal and valid, and said plat is hereby declared to be conclusive evidence of the location of said road in any court or proceedings in this state.

Legalisation of road so changed—what deemed evidence of location of said road.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.

CHAPTER XXXIX.

An Act to authorize the town of West St. Paul, in Dakota County, to issue bonds to redeem city orders of said West St. Paul.

March 2, 1870.

SECTION 1. Authorized to issue bonds—in what amount—for what purpose—at what rate of interest.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the town of West St. Paul, in the county of Dakota, is hereby authorized and empowered to issue the bonds of said town to an amount not exceeding five thousand dollars, to run five years, and to bear interest at seven per cent. per annum, in such denominations as the supervisors of said town may by resolution prescribe, for the purpose of taking up and redeeming the city orders of said West St. Paul, commonly known as West St. Paul city scrip, and bearing interest at the rate of twelve per cent. per annum.

To issue bonds—amount—for what purpose—rate of interest.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER XL.

March 3, 1870.

An Act to legalize and confirm certain proceedings in the Towns of LeSueur and Ottawa, in the County of LeSueur, and declaring certain lands a part of LeSueur township, and legalizing the actions of the Board of Supervisors of said towns in relation to said lands.

- ENACTED 1. All acts and proceedings of said towns done in pursuance of law are hereby legalized.
2. Description of territory annexed to the town of LeSueur—not to exempt said territory from prior indebtedness.
3. Proceedings heretofore had relative to said lands are hereby legalized and made valid.
4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

All acts of said towns legalized.

SECTION 1. That all acts and proceedings of the towns of LeSueur and Ottawa, in the county of LeSueur, heretofore done under and in pursuance of an act entitled "an act to annex a portion of the township of Ottawa to the township of LeSueur," approved March second, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and sixty-five, are hereby legalized and confirmed, and made valid in all respects.

Territory Annexed to the town of LeSueur—not to exempt prior indebtedness.

SEC. 2. That sections one and two, and lots number one and two in section three, lot three in section ten, lot one and the north-east quarter, and the east half of the north-west quarter, and the south-west quarter of the north-west quarter of section eleven, and the north half of section twelve, all in township number one hundred and eleven north, of range twenty-six west, are hereby
