CHAPTER XLIX.

An Act to amend Section Two, Chapter Forty-Four, of the Special Laws of One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Nine, entitled "an act to amend Chapter Twenty-Four of the Special Laws of One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-Eight, entitled an act to authorize the towns of Fillmore, Mower, Freeborn, Faribault, Martin and Jackson counties, to issue bonds to aid in the construction of any Railroads running into or through said counties."

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Repeal of former

SECTION 1. That section two of chapter forty-four of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixtynine, be amended by striking therefrom the following words: "That none of the provisions of this act shall apply to the counties of Faribault, Martin and Jackson, or to the bonds to be issued by any of the towns of said counties by virtue of the powers conferred in the act of March sixth, one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight."

When act to take effect,

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
