An Act to amend Section Three, Chapter One Hundred and Fourteen, Session Laws of One Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty-Eight, relating to the Stevens Seminary.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section Three (3) of Chapter One Hundred and Fourteen (114) of , the Special Laws of 1866, When all right to fund named in this Section forfelted

1. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section three, chapter one hundred and fourteen, session laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-eight, be amended so that after the words, " Provided, further," in the twenty-fourth line, as to read as follows:

When all right to build a good substantial building, suitable for a graded this section for-school, and sufficient for the school, and sufficient for the accommodation of one hundred scholars, and commence a school therein by the sixth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and seventytwo, it shall forfeit all right to the fund named in this section, and the legislature may direct its use for other educational purposes in McLeod county. Provided. That said building shall not cost less than two thousand dollars. SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
