

CHAPTER CXII.

An Act to appropriate money for certain purposes therein named.

March 3, 1871.

SECTION 1. Appropriation from General Revenue Fund.

1. To E. P. Freeman and W. Schimmel, commissioners appointed to view bridge across Big Cottonwood River.
2. To J. T. Averill, O. C. Merriman and J. S. Pillsbury, committee appointed to view bridge across Rum River.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated:

First.—To E. P. Freeman and W. Schimmel, for expenses incurred in discharge of duties as commissioners appointed to view a bridge across the Big Cottonwood river, in accordance with the provisions of chapter one hundred and one of the general laws of the state of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, sixty dollars.

Appropriation to pay bridge viewers.

Second.—To J. T. Averill, O. C. Merriman and J. S. Pillsbury, for expenses incurred in the discharge of duties as committee appointed on part of the state to view a bridge across the Rum river at Anoka, in accordance with the provisions of chapter ninety-eight of the general laws of the state of Minnesota for the year one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, forty dollars.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
