CHAPTER CXIV.

An Act to appropriate money to pay the claims of Mathias
Theis and Mathias Mergens.

March 3, 1871.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for certain purposes therein named:

- 1. To Mathias Theis, for value of horse taken in Indian campaign.
- 2. To Mathlas Mergens, for damage to horse taken in Indian campaign.
- To Ferdinand Monte, for supplies furnished Wisconsin troops in Indian campaign.
- 2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. That the following sums of money be and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund, not otherwise appropriated, viz:

First.—To Mathias Theis (Hartman), for value of horse taken by order of Brigadier General Sibley, in Indian campaign which died in and from the effects of the service, one hundred and twenty five dollars (\$125 00). Appropriation

Second.—To Mathias Mergens, for damages to horse for certain purtaken by order of Brigadier General Sibley, in Indian named.

campaign, ninety dollars (\$90 00).

Third.—To Ferdinand Monte, for boarding and supplies furnished to soldiers of the twenty-fifth regiment of Wisconsin volunteers during the Indian campaign of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-two, one hundred and eight dollars (\$108 00).
