CHAPTER CXVII.

March 8, 1871 An Act to appropriate money for certain purposes therein named.

SECTION 1. Appropriation for certain purposes therein named.

1. To G. C. Chamberlin, for expenses incurred in contested election.

2. To G. W. Whallon, for expenses incurred in contested election.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

That the following sums of money be, SECTION 1. and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

First.-To G. C. Chamberlin, to reimburse him for expenses incurred in the contested election case of A. L. Patchin against him for a seat in the house of representatives, the sum of five hundred and twenty-eight collars

and eighty-three cents (\$528 83). Second.—To G. W. Whallon, to reimburse him for expenses incurred in the contested election case of C. W. Thompson against him for a seat in the state senate, the sum of one hundred and fifty-dollars (\$150).

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from When not to take and after its passage.
