

CHAPTER CXVII.

March 3, 1871*An Act to appropriate money for certain purposes therein named.*

SECTION 1. Appropriation for certain purposes therein named.

1. To G. C. Chamberlin, for expenses incurred in contested election.
2. To G. W. Whallon, for expenses incurred in contested election.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the following sums of money be, and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated.

Appropriation
for purposes
therein named,

First.—To G. C. Chamberlin, to reimburse him for expenses incurred in the contested election case of A. L. Patchin against him for a seat in the house of representatives, the sum of five hundred and twenty-eight dollars and eighty-three cents (\$528 83).

Second.—To G. W. Whallon, to reimburse him for expenses incurred in the contested election case of C. W. Thompson against him for a seat in the state senate, the sum of one hundred and fifty-dollars (\$150).

When act to take
effect,

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
