

CHAPTER CXXI.

An Act to appropriate money for certain purposes therein named.

March 3, 1871.

SECTION 1. Appropriation to pay expenses of locating and viewing a bridge—in what amount.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the sum of thirty-nine dollars be, and the same are hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury belonging to the general revenue fund not otherwise appropriated, as compensation to the persons herein named, for locating and viewing a bridge in the town of Mound Prairie, in accordance with the authority conferred in chapter one hundred, of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, in sums to each as follows:
