CHAPTER VII.

*An Act to Prevent Frauds in the Purchase of School Books, Apparatus and Furniture for the use of Schools.* March 6, 1871.

SECTION 1. Who not to be interested in the sale of books, apparatus, or furniture to be used in any school.

2. Penalty for violation of the provisions of this act.
3. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :*

SECTION 1. No teacher, state, county, township, or district school officer, shall be interested in the sale, proceeds or profits of any book, apparatus or furniture used or to be used in any school in this state, with which such officer or teacher may be connected. Who not to be interested in sale of books, etc.

SEC. 2. Any such teacher or officer who shall receive any commission or compensation, either directly or indirectly, for the sale of any book, apparatus or furniture, used or to be used in any school in this state, upon conviction thereof by complaint before a justice of the peace, shall be fined not less than fifty nor more than two hundred dollars for each such offence. Penalty for violation of provisions of this act.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
