

## CHAPTER LXXXVI.

*An Act to provide for terms of the District Court in the county of Carlton.* March 6, 1871.

- SECTION 1. Time of holding terms of District Court in Carlton county.  
 2. All writs, recognizances, etc., deemed to be returned to such court.  
 3. Repeal of inconsistent acts.  
 4. When act to take effect.

*Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:*

SECTION 1. That general terms of the district court shall be held in the county of Carlton, in the seventh judicial district of this state, on the first Tuesday of August and the second Tuesday of February in each year. Time of holding terms of District Court.

SEC. 2. All judicial proceedings now pending in, and all writs and recognizances returnable to the district court in the county of St. Louis from the said county of Carlton, shall be and are hereby made pending in and returnable to the district court in said Carlton county, and to the term next succeeding the passage of this act as provided herein. Where writs, etc., deemed returnable.

SEC. 3. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed. Repeal of inconsistent acts.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
