

CHAPTER C.

March 1, 1871. *An Act to provide for the organization of the County of Becker.*

- SECTION 1. Organization of the County of Becker.
2. Appointment of County Commissioners—term of office.
 3. Board of Commissioners to fill county offices by appointment—term of office.
 4. Repeal of inconsistent acts.
 5. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Organization of
said county.

SECTION 1. That the county of Becker in this state, be and the same is hereby declared to be an organized county, with all the rights, privileges and immunities of other organized counties, within this state.

Commissioners
appointed—term
of office.

SEC. 2. The governor of this state shall within ten (10) days after the passage of this act, appoint three (3) qualified electors of said county of Becker, as commissioners of said county, and the said commissioners shall as soon as may be after their appointment, meet at the house of M. M. Tyler, and qualify and enter upon the duties of their offices, and they shall hold their offices until the next general election, and until their successors are elected and qualified.

County officers,
how appointed—
term of office.

SEC. 3. The county commissioners appointed and qualified according to the provisions of section two (2) of this act, shall at their first meeting or at any meeting thereafter, appoint qualified persons to fill all the county offices in said county, except clerk of the district court, who shall be appointed by the judge of said court, which person so appointed and having qualified, shall hold offices until the next general election and until their successors are elected and qualified.

Repeal of incon-
sistent acts.

SEC. 4. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with the provisions of this act, are hereby repealed.

SEC. 5. This act shall take effect and be in force from When act to take effect.

CHAPTER CI.

An Act to authorize the Auditor of State, to draw his orders for certain moneys therein named. March 1, 1871.

Preamble.

- SECTION 1. Duty of State Auditor.
2. When act to take effect.

WHEREAS, Section four of chapter one hundred of the general laws of one thousand eight hundred and sixty-nine, authorizes the auditor of state upon the conditions of said chapter being complied with, to draw his order or orders in favor of the treasurer of Houston county, on the state treasurer, to aid in building certain bridges in the towns of Mound Prairie and Houston, in the county of Houston. Therefore, Preamble.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the state auditor is hereby authorized and required when the bridge in the town of Mound Prairie, named in said chapter is built, in accordance with the terms of said chapter, to draw the orders therein named to an amount not exceeding fifteen hundred dollars. Duty of State Auditor.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
