

CHAPTER CVI.

An Act to abolish the Independent School District of Pleasant Grove, in the County of Olmsted and State of Minnesota. March 6, 1871.

- SECTION 1. School District abolished, how.
2. When election to be held.
 3. Disposition of moneys belonging to said district.
 4. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That the legal voters of the independent school district of Pleasant Grove are hereby authorized to abolish said independent school district by a vote of the electors of said school district. School District abolished, how.

SEC. 2. The election for this purpose shall be held on the last Saturday in March, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-one, at the usual place of holding elections in said district. When election to be held.

SEC. 3. All moneys belonging to said independent school district shall be equitably and legally apportioned to the several sub-districts within the bounds of said independent school district; *Provided*, Said independent school district is abolished as above. Disposition of moneys belonging to district.

SEC. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
