CHAPTER XIV.

An Act to amend the City Charter of the City of Red Wing, in relation to Immunities of Firemen.

March 6, 1871.

SECTION 1. Amendment to Section two (2), Chapter four (4), of Chapter six (6), Special Laws of 1864. Council to purchase fire engines and other fire apparatus—exemptions of firemen.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Section 1. Subdivision thirty-seven of section two of chapter four of said charter as amended in 1864, is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Thirty-seventh.—The city council shall have power to council to purpurchase fire engines and other fire apparatus, and to chase free engines authorize the formation of fire engine, hook and ladder paratus—axempand hose companies, and to provide for the due support tons of free and regulation of the same; and to order such companies to be disbanded and their apparatus delivered up. Each company shall not have to exceed seventy-five members, and shall be formed by voluntary enlistment, and each member of such company shall be exempt from poll tax, from serving on juries, and from military duty, during the continuance of such membership; and such members, after five years' service in such companies, shall be thereafter free from poll taxes, service on juries, and military duty except in cases of insurrection or invasion.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.
