

CHAPTER CXLII.

An Act to change the name of the town of Lillian, in the county of Goodhue, to that of Stanton. March 6, 1871.

SECTION 1. Name of the town of Lillian changed to that of Stanton.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. That part of township one hundred and twelve north, of range eighteen west, lying south of Cannon River, and heretofore known and designated as the town of Lillian, in the county of Goodhue, shall hereafter be known and designated as the town of Stanton; *Provided*, That such change shall not prejudice any existing rights, claims, or liabilities. Change of name.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
