

CHAPTER CL.

January 17, 1871. *An Act to change the name of the township of Shakopee, in Scott county, to that of "Jackson."*

SECTION 1. Name of the town of Shakopee changed to that of Jackson.

2. Not to affect the right of the officers or citizens.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Change of name.

SECTION 1. That the name of the township of Shakopee, in the county of Scott, and state of Minnesota, be, and the same is hereby changed to, and will be hereafter known, as the township of Jackson.

Not to affect the rights of officers or citizens.

SEC. 2. The officers of said township of Shakopee, and all records and proceedings thereof shall continue to be the officers, and records and proceedings of the said township of Jackson, in the same manner as if the aforesaid change of name had not been made.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
