CHAPTER XXIII.

An Act to amend an act to incorporate the Borough of New Ulm, and to repeal its present acts of incorporation, approved February nineteenth, one thousand eight hundred and seventy. March 1, 1871.

- SECTION 1. Amendment to Section three (3), Chapter one (1), of Chapter six (6), Special Laws of 1870. Style of all ordinances.
2. Amendment to Section one (1), Chapter two (2), of said act. Strike out and insert.
3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. Section three of chapter one of said act is hereby amended so as to read as follows:

Sec. 3. The style of all ordinances shall be, Be it ordained by the council of the borough of New Ulm. Style of all ordinances.

SEC. 2. The word "recorder," in section one of chapter two of said act shall be stricken out, and the words "justice of the peace to be styled borough justice" inserted in lieu thereof, and wherever the word "recorder" occurs in said act it shall be stricken out and the words "borough justice" inserted in place thereof. Strike out and insert.

SEC. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
