

CHAPTER XL.

An Act allowing citizens to lower the waters of Lake Elysian.

March 6, 1871.

SECTION 1. Authorized to lower the water in said lake—how damages may be ascertained.

1. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota :

SECTION 1. The citizens or any of the citizens of Janesville, or of the county of Waseca, are hereby permitted to lower the waters of lake Elysian, in said county of Waseca, through the outlet running southward, to the extent of three feet. *Provided*, That before lowering the waters of said lake consent in writing of each of the persons owning the lands upon the shore of said lake, shall be procured and filed in the office of the register of deeds of the county in which the same is situate ; and in case any person refuse to consent, that the damages, if any, may be appraised as provided by chapter thirty-one of the general statutes.

Authorized to lower the waters in said lake—damages, how ascertained.

SEC. 2. This act shall be in force from and after its passage.

When act to take effect.
