## CHAPTER XLI.

An Act to authorize the City of Minneapolis, to make a contract for the superintending and keeping in repair of the Water Works of said city.

- SECTION 1. Council authorized to enter into a contract for the purposes herein specified—
  power to annul contract.
  - 2. When sot to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Authorised to enter into a contract—for what purpose—power to annul contract

Section 1. That the common council of the city of Minneapolis, is hereby authorized to make and enter into a contract with any person for the general superintendance and keeping in repair, by said person, of the water works of said city. Such contract shall be executed in the same manner that contracts are usually executed by said city, and may run for such time, be conditioned for the performance of such services, and the furnishing of such materials, and for such compensation therefor as may be agreed upon by said contracting parties; and when duly made and executed, shall be binding and obligatory upon them and each of them. *Provided*, That the council, by a vote of two-thirds of the aldermen elect, shall have the power to annul such contract for cause.

When act to take SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
