

CHAPTER XLIV.

March 3, 1871.

An Act to sever a portion of the Territory now comprising the town of Inver Grove, in the county of Dakota, Minnesota, and annex the same to the town of Rosemount, in said county.

- SECTION 1. Description of territory severed from the town of Inver Grove and attached to the town of Rosemount.
2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

Description of territory.

SECTION 1. That lots one (1) and two (2) of section seven (7), and sections sixteen (16), seventeen (17), eighteen (18), nineteen (19), twenty (20), twenty-one (21), twenty-eight (28), twenty-nine (29), thirty (30), thirty-one (31), thirty two (32), thirty-three (33), of township number one hundred and fifteen (115), range number eighteen (18), be and the same are hereby severed from the said town of Inver Grove, and annexed to and made a part of the town of Rosemount, in said county of Dakota.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
