

“ against issuing court-house bonds.” The votes shall be counted, returned and canvassed in the same manner as provided by law in the election of county officers. Said bonds or obligations and coupons if issued, shall be signed by the said town supervisors, or a majority of them, and attested by the clerk of said town, and shall obligate said town to the payment of the same according to the tenor and import thereof, and shall be used exclusively in the purchase or procurement of a court house and grounds for said county of Carver, in said town of Chaska; and such bonds or obligations and coupons shall be binding and obligatory upon said town, and there shall be annually levied upon the taxable property of said town in addition to all other taxes, a tax sufficient to meet the interest as it becomes due upon said bonds or obligations, and also a tax to meet the principal when due.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.

CHAPTER XLIX.

An Act to extend the jurisdiction of the Borough of St. Peter, in the County of Nicollet, over the roadway and bridges leading from said borough into the County of Le Sueur, to the railroad depot of the St. Paul and Sioux City Railroad, and thence to the foot of the bluff beyond.

March 6, 1871.

SECTION 1. Council authorised to extend and exercise full and complete jurisdiction over said road.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the common council and corporate authorities of the borough of St. Peter, in the county of

Council to have complete jurisdiction over said road.

Nicollet, are hereby authorized to extend and exercise full and complete jurisdiction over the roadway and bridges in the county of Le Sueur, leading and extending from said borough to the depot of the St. Paul and Sioux City railroad, and thence to the foot of the bluff beyond (such jurisdiction not to exceed beyond the said foot of said bluff), so far as to permit the common council and corporate authorities of said borough, its officers and agents, to construct, improve, and keep in repair the said road and bridges between said borough and the foot of said bluff, and by ordinance or otherwise to regulate the travel thereon, in like manner as if said road and bridges were within the corporate limits of said borough.

When act to take effect.

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

CHAPTER L.

An Act to legalize the first charter election of the Village of Kasson, in the County of Dodge, and the acts and proceedings of the officers of said village.

February 21, 1871

SECTION 1. Charter election declared to be legalized.

2. Validity of the officers elect.

3. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the charter election of the village of Kasson, in the county of Dodge, held in said village on the fourth day of April, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and seventy, and conducted by Jonathan Owen, J. E. Bunker and Simon Gerould, be and the same is hereby in all things legalized and made valid.

Charter election declared to be legalized.
