CHAPTER LXI.

An Act to exempt the County of Dakota from the operation of Chapter forty-five of the Special Laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy, authorizing certain counties to issue bonds to railroad companies.

March 9, 1871.

SECTION 1. Amendment to section one (1), Ohapter forty-five (46), Special Laws of 1870. Towns in said counties authorized to lasue bonds-for what purpose.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That section one of chapter forty-five of the special laws of one thousand eight hundred and seventy be amended to read as follows:

Sec. 1. Each township, village, town, and incorpo-Authorized to israted city, in the counties of Mower, Dodge and Good- sue bonds-in hue, by a vote of a majority of the supervisors of any tor what amounttownship, or of the majority of the city council of any such village, town, or city, subject to the approval and ratification of the legal voters of said township, village, town, or city, as hereinafter provided, may create and issue its bonds, with interest coupons attached, to aid in the construction of any railroad running into or proposed to be built through either or all of the counties aforesaid.

SEC. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent with Bepeal of inconsistent acts, this act are hereby repealed.
