

CHAPTER LXVIII.

An Act to authorize the West Wisconsin Railway Company, to erect a bridge across St. Croix River or Lake. March 6, 1871.

SECTION 1. Authorized to construct and maintain a bridge.

2. When act to take effect.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Minnesota:

SECTION 1. That the West Wisconsin Railway Company, are hereby authorized to construct and maintain a bridge over the St. Croix river in this state, at any point north of the southern line of the corporate limits of the city of Stillwater; but no bridge shall be constructed by the said company at any point on said river or lake St. Croix, south of said corporate limits; *Provided however, that said bridge shall not obstruct the free navigation of said river and lake.* Authorized to construct and maintain a bridge

SEC. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage. When act to take effect.
